We are blessed with one of the finest music programs in the Diocese. For many, just hearing the Choir has been a gateway to church membership. With a good mixture of volunteer parishioners and paid section leaders, our Choir sings God's praise in regular weekly services and special events like the All Souls' Requiem, Choral Evensong, and the Festival of Lessons and Carols.

Youth Group, Sunday School, and Noah's Nursery provide loving care and Christian formation throughout the school year. Christ Church also receives an annual visit from St. Nicholas, one of many fun and informative events for our young people, which lay the foundation for a lifetime of faith and service.

One component of our Outreach is hands-on and financial support of the Huntington Interfaith Homeless Initiative. These cooks and dishwashers from Christ Church have just served up hot meals for two dozen homeless workers on a cold winter's night! St Hilda's Guild, the Community Garden, and the Outreach Grants Committee are other examples of good work for good causes.

Our historic core buildings are the current Church (1878), the Parish Hall (1892) and the Rectory (1802). The beauty and interest of these buildings combined with our magnificent gardens and grounds make Christ Church a special destination for visitors and a lively focus of the local community. Their care and maintenance is now entrusted to us, for future generations.

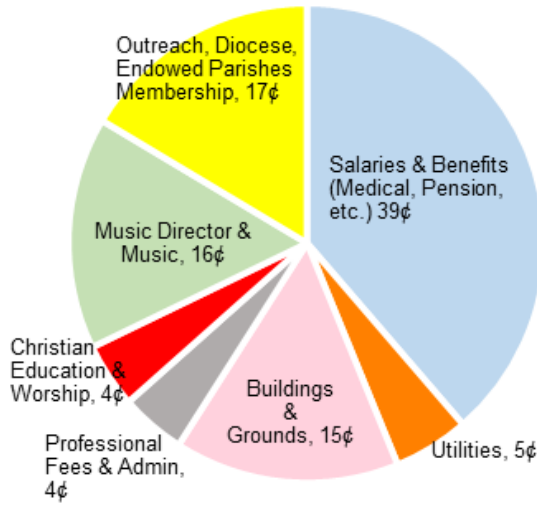
